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# Soil, Slope & Sunshine

The Yakima Valley Appellation

An appellation, or AVA (American Viticultural Area), is a designated geographical region that possesses unique climate, soil and physical features which distinguish it from surrounding areas. This combination of soil, slope and sunshine influences the growth and character of the grapes, which in turn produces wines distinctive in personality to that appellation.



Established in 1983, the Yakima Valley was the first Washington State AVA, and is now home to more than 75 wineries and over one-third of the state's vineyards, boasting over 12,000 acres of premium wine grapes.

Here's a look at how soil, slope and sunshine come together to produce great wine in the Yakima Valley:

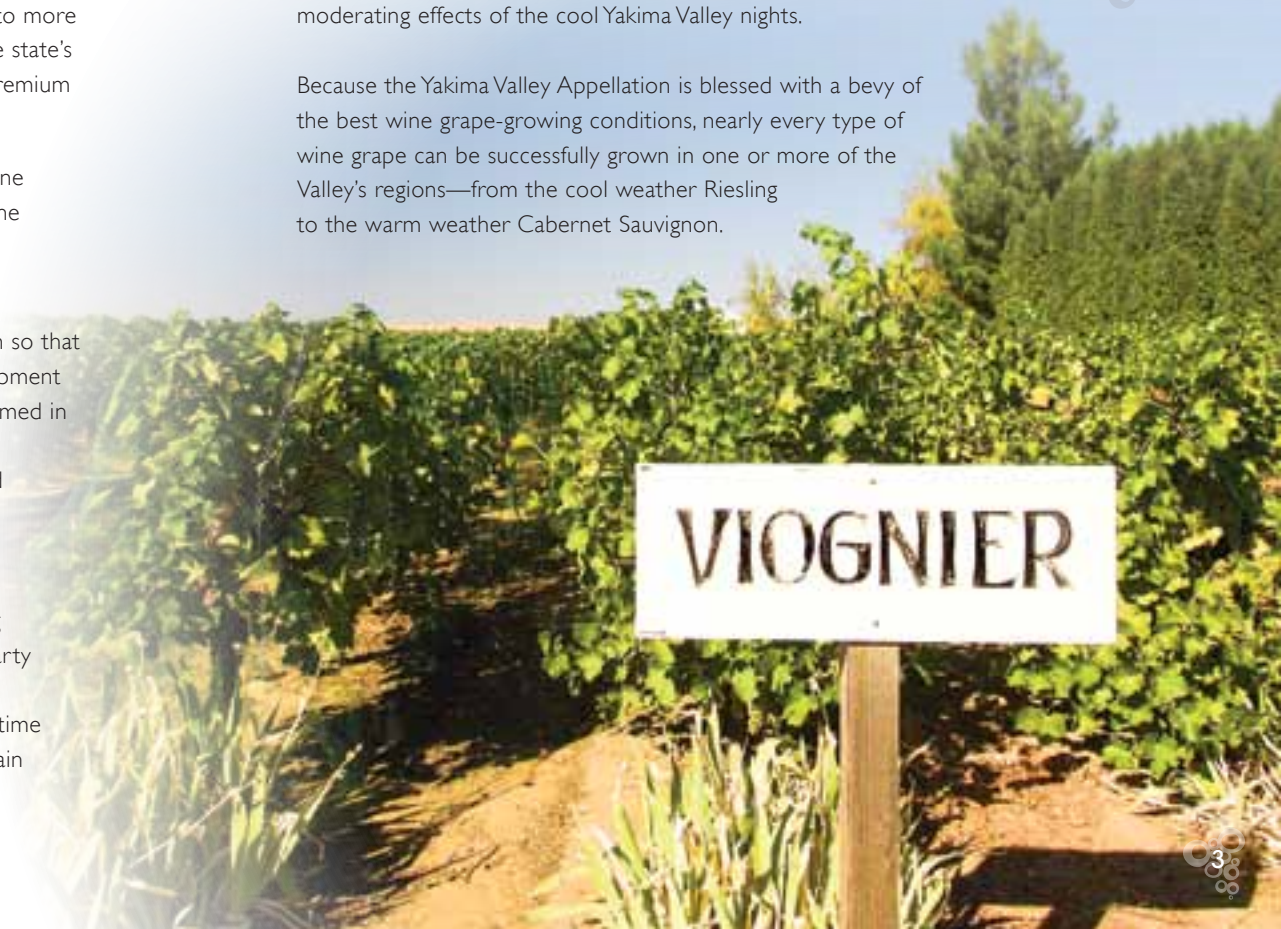
**SOIL** When growing wine grapes, it is important that the soil is loose enough so that water does not accumulate in the ground, causing a slowdown in flavor development in the fruit. The Yakima Valley was sculpted by a number of ancient wrinkles formed in the land when volcanoes cooled and sank, leaving behind a large basalt layer in the earth. Prehistoric floods then aided in creating optimal soils as they layered the basalt with deposits of fine silt, loam, loess and cobble—each offering the proper drainage necessary to keep the vine's vigor under control.

**SLOPE** The sunny slopes of the Yakima Valley foothills are blessed with a long growing period, extended daylight hours, and cool evenings that yield bold, hearty and luscious world-class wines. Hot summer days and cool nights provide the perfect growing environment. This large fluctuation between daytime and nighttime temperatures is considered key by winemakers and wine grape growers to attain intense varietal character. The Valley's cold winters kill pests that are prevalent

in other, milder wine growing regions throughout the United States, reducing the need for chemical repellents on the fruit.

**SUNSHINE** Within the framework of sunshine we include all climate factors. Beyond sunlight, we look for sufficient irrigation to promote natural sugar development and to the temperature-moderating effects of the cool Yakima Valley nights.

Because the Yakima Valley Appellation is blessed with a bevy of the best wine grape-growing conditions, nearly every type of wine grape can be successfully grown in one or more of the Valley's regions—from the cool weather Riesling to the warm weather Cabernet Sauvignon.

Ask any Yakima Valley winemaker and they'll tell you: *great wine begins in the vineyard.* The art of winemaking is to allow the land to express itself in the grapes, and the grapes to express themselves in the wine. That's why many of the Valley's winemakers settled here. Great soil and great weather are the basics of great wine. Meet a few of our growers:



## LARRY PEARSON – TAPTEIL VINEYARD

Tapteil Vineyard is located within the Red Mountain AVA and includes 25 acres of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. First planted in 1985, Tapteil is planted on Warden silt-loam soils between the elevations of 750 and 900 feet.



## TODD NEWHOUSE – UPLAND VINEYARDS

Upland Vineyards is located entirely within the Snipes Mountain AVA in the heart of the Valley. Farming grapes since 1968, four generations of the Newhouse family have maintained the Upland legacy that started over 90 years ago. Originally planted by W.B. Bridgman in 1917, Snipes Mountain is considered the birthplace of Washington Wine.



## LEIF OLSEN – OLSEN VINEYARDS

Olsen Vineyards are planted on several different sites in the east end of the Valley with a wide variety of slopes, aspects, and elevations. The family has been farming since 1908, planting their first vineyard in 1980. Leif and his cousin, Martin, are fourth generation farmers continuing the legacy of passion for their land and crops.



## PATRICK RAWN – COPELAND VINEYARD

Copeland Vineyard, planted in 2000 at the western end of the Valley in the Rattlesnake Hills sub-AVA, consists of 26 acres of south-facing vineyards. Patrick is the third generation to farm the land that was originally planted in apples by his grandfather in 1954. The vineyard is named for a family member who was an early settler in the area.

### Klipsun Vineyards

Named one of the Top 25 Vineyards in the world by *Wine & Spirits Magazine*, Klipsun Vineyard is located on Red Mountain, on the eastern border of the Yakima Valley Appellation. Klipsun may be one of the most respected vineyards in Washington State and particularly noted as one of the best maintained—a tribute to vineyard manager, Julia Kock.

The vineyard was planted by David and Patricia Gelles in 1984 to mostly bilateral cordon with an average of 726 vines to the acre. Known for its dark cherry fruit flavors and bold, masculine characteristics, Klipsun's soil composition is mainly sandy loam, the majority of which was deposited during the Missoula floods. The vineyard faces west with approximately 120 acres of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Malbec, Nebbiolo, Sauvignon Blanc, and Semillon.

Characterized by warm daytime temperatures and low nighttime temperatures, the fruit receives near perfect heat and light toward the end of the day.

Currently, about 35 producers purchase Klipsun grapes, among them DeLille, Januik, JM Cellars, Seven Hills, and Quilceda Creek. It takes a while for winemakers to learn how to make a wine from Klipsun fruit so that it is not too big. For that reason, many producers blend the masculine Klipsun fruit with more refined feminine Yakima Valley fruit from vineyards like Ciel du Cheval and Boushey.

## The Diverse Character of the Yakima Valley

**T**he Yakima Valley Appellation is proud to be the oldest and most diverse wine growing region in Washington State. The outstanding grapes grown in Yakima Valley are the key ingredient in more than half of all the wine produced throughout Washington State, making it the backbone of the Washington wine industry. The appellation is situated near the Yakima River at Wapato and runs to Benton City,

Washington, which offers an 80-mile stretch of rural countryside. It is the series of small wine communities in and around this stretch that make up Yakima Valley's wine country.

### WINDOW ON WINE COUNTRY FROM SELAH AND NACHES HEIGHTS

Take a look at these unique Yakima Valley wineries. Each winery featured here presents a unique and picturesque window on wine country. This wine

community features the wineries on Naches Heights, such as Naches Heights Vineyard and Wilridge Winery. A short drive to Selah offers an exceptional experience at Southard Winery, a young winery making a tremendous mark on the industry.

**THINGS ARE AFOOT IN DOWNTOWN YAKIMA** One of the best things about Yakima—the little berg that could, located on the west side of wine country—is that it is wonderfully self-contained. The truly beautiful thing about downtown Yakima, all two-miles wide of it, is that indeed it is so compact that it is one of the few destinations of its caliber that can be easily accessed entirely by foot. Park your car and tour wineries such as Kana Winery, Gilbert Cellars and the newest addition, Treveri Cellars.

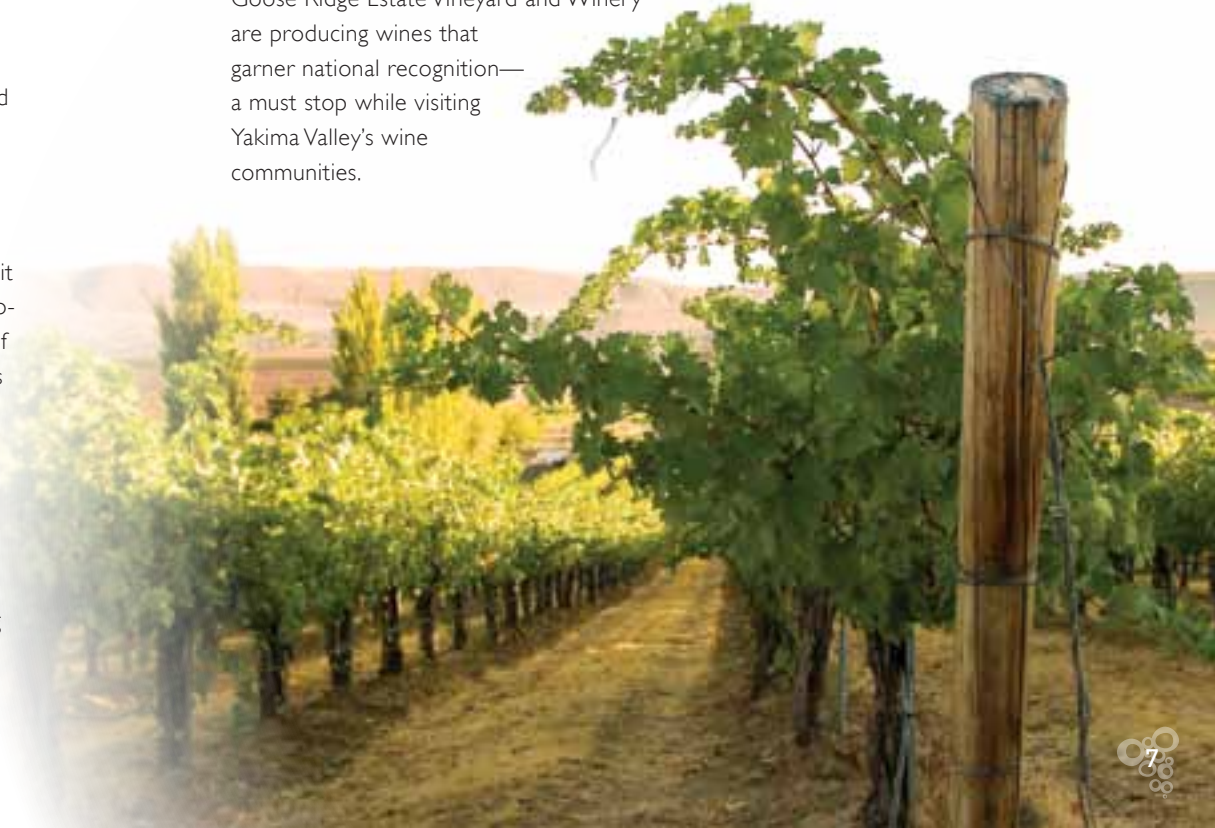
**A YOUTHFUL AND VIBRANT WINE COMMUNITY - ZILLAH** Much of the youth coming into the industry in the Yakima Valley hail from Zillah. Visit the following wineries and talk to those who have chosen the wine industry as their profession. These wineries include Two Mountain Winery, Cultura Wine, Dineen Family Vineyard, and Severino Cellars and they make up a young, upbeat, neighborhood. While touring the neighborhood, you can't miss visiting more established wineries such as Silver Lake, Claar Cellars, Wineglass Cellars, Maison de Padgett or Horizon's Edge Winery.

**QUIET CHARMS OF PROSSER** Discover the quiet charms of laid-back Prosser.

In the Yakima Valley, wine country is always within striking distance. And while there is something to be said for a visit to Cab country, it can be just as rewarding to step into a sleepy wine town with the old-time charm. This community offers wine tasting from more than 13 wineries in Prosser, Wine Town USA.

**ROADS LESS TRAVELED IN AND AROUND RED MOUNTAIN** Take the back

roads to a selection of unique and appealing Yakima Valley wineries. Travelers know that sometimes the best roads are the back roads, where the pace is slower, the path less crowded and the experience more genuine. The Red Mountain region located in Benton City features Oakwood Cellars, Terra Blanca Winery, Kiona Vineyards, Hightower Cellars and Tapteil Vineyard Winery. This wine community includes the Valley's eastern border, which includes Richland. Barnard Griffin Winery and Goose Ridge Estate Vineyard and Winery are producing wines that garner national recognition—a must stop while visiting Yakima Valley's wine communities.
